

Participation/Weekly Assignment Rubric

Each week you will receive feedback about your participation and weekly assignments. You can earn 0-5 points for each week. You will receive a rubric below with your level of participation highlighted. Your participation points will be calculated by adding the number for each criterion that you demonstrated and dividing the sum by 6 (the number of criteria).

5 = Average rating of 4.5 - 5

4 = Average rating of 3.5 - 4.49

3 = Average rating of 2.5 - 3.49

2 = Average rating of 1.5 - 2.49

1 = Average rating of 0.5 - 1.49

0 = Average rating of < 0.5
